To be eligible, all applicants must:

- (a) Be under 35 years of age **and** have less than five years of practice;
- (b) Be fluent in both written and spoken English (given this is the conference language);
- (c) Have taken an active role in the legal profession in their countries;
- (d) Currently be involved in a cross-border practice or wish to become engaged in a crossborder practice; and
- (e) Have published an article in a reputable journal on some topic related to the work of one of the IPBA Committees or provide some other objective evidence of committed involvement in the profession.

Preference will be given to those applicants who could not otherwise attend the conference due to personal and family financial circumstances and/or because they are employed by a small firm which could not afford to send them to the conference.

Eligibility Criteria for Lawyers in Developing Countries:

To be eligible, all applicants must:

- (a) Be an indigenous lawyer in Vietnam, Laos, Cambodia, Myanmar, Mongolia or the Pacific Islands;
- (b) Be fluent in both written and spoken English (given this is the conference language); and
- (c) Currently be involved in a cross-border practice or wish to become engaged in a crossborder practice.
